This is in reference to the Office of the Attorney General of Guam's Request for Proposal No. 001-2016 (RFP) issued on February 19, 2016.

This is to amend the following pages of the aforementioned RFP, as amended: Pages 2, 5, 7, 8, and 9.

1. Page 2: 1.1 – TABLE TIMELINE; the entire timeline contained within page 2 is repealed and replaced as follows:

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2. Page 5: 2.2.4 – TIME AND DATE FOR RECEIPT OF PROPOSALS; Deadline contained under Date marked Thursday, March 31, 2016 is replaced to read:

Friday, April 29, 2016

3. Pages 7-8: 2.3.1 - PRE-PROPOSAL CONFERENCE; Last paragraph which begins on page 7 and continues to page 8 is amended to exclude the following sentence (bolded and stricken through):

Pre-Proposal Conference(s), as appropriate, may be conducted in accordance with 2 GAR Div. 4 § 3109(g)(4) (Pre-Proposal Conferences). Such a conference may be held at any time prior to the established date for submission of proposals. A pre-proposal conference will be held on March 11, 2016, at 2:00 p.m., at the 9th floor conference room of the Attorney General's Office. Attorneys **may** be present to pick up confidential packet after first executing the Offeror Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement, or alternatively contact Chief Prosecutor, Phillip Tydingco @ 488-1956 or email ptydingco@guamag.org to make arrangements to pick up packet after first executing the Offeror Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement. ~~**Failure to pick up packet and sign the Offeror Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement will deem proposals non-responsive (See 2.3.1).**~~ Upon the Attorney signing the confidentiality and non-disclosure agreement, a confidential packet containing information thus far received by the OAG will be released for the purpose of attorneys or law firms to review the matter for conflicts, to create a proposal and to determine cost estimates. Each attorney will also agree that the confidential packets will not be duplicated and returned back to OAG on or before the submission date and time of the RFP.

4. Page 8: 2.3.2 - PRE-PROPOSAL WRITTEN QUESTIONS; Second paragraph is replaced to read:

Questions regarding this RFP **must** be received in writing by OAG by:



Note: All remaining language in 2.3.2 is unchanged.

5. Page 8-9: 2.3.3 – PRE-PROPOSAL CONFLICTS CHECK; first paragraph beginning on page 8 and continuing to page 9 has been amended to read:

A **confidential information** packet of potential names will be made available to Potential Offerors beginning March 11, 2016. Each potential Offeror is ethically responsible to review the **confidential information packet** and to determine if a conflict exists. ~~**The list of names are not all inclusive, additional names may be added based on the winning offeror's investigation.**~~ Failure to pick up the confidential information packet and sign the Offeror Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement by April 22, 2016 will deem proposals non-responsive.
