

Dear Prospective Offerors:

This **NOTICE** is to advise you that the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) received two letters on April 14, 2015. One letter requested responses to questions, and the other letter was a **protest** regarding **RFP No. 001-2016 – Request For Proposal, Professional Services, Independent Prosecutor (Special Assistant Attorney General)**. The purposes of the RFP are to contract legal services from a qualified Attorney or Law Firm to perform the duties of an Independent Prosecutor (Special Assistant Attorney General) to review evidence and investigate if necessary, as well as determine if criminal charges and further prosecution are warranted, in connection with acts or omissions of officials and or employees of the Government of Guam that resulted in retroactive payments made to unclassified Government of Guam employees in December of 2014 or thereafter in violation of Guam law and retroactive pay reimbursements. However, pursuant to 5 G.C.A. §5425(g), the Office of the Attorney General shall not proceed further with the solicitation or award of a contract under this RFP prior to final resolution of the protest.

Once the protest is resolved, the OAG will advise you.

Therefore, this a Notice of Stay of Procurement of this RFP that shall remain in effect until the protest is resolved.
