**QUALIFICATION
REQUIREMENTS**

Pursuant to 10 GCA, § 81103.1, applicants must possess the following:

Shall be a citizen, a permanent resident of the United States, or a person whose immigration status with the U.S. Immigration legally allows him to work in the United States, and a physician licensed to practice his profession in Guam. He must have current certification in Forensic Pathology by the American Board of Pathology or the American Osteopathic Board of Pathology or their successors.

**DOCUMENTATION
REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants claiming educational accomplishments are required to submit official or verified copies of transcripts or diplomas. The diploma, degree, or credits required must come from an education institution that is accredited or recognized by either its government or a government recognized accrediting agency. This applies to all new employment after October 1, 2008 pursuant to Public Law 29-113.

**PROHIBITION
PURSUANT TO P.L. 28-98**

No person convicted of a sex offense under the provisions of Chapter 25 of Title 9 GCA, or an offense as defined in Article 2 of Chapter 28, Title 9 GCA in Guam, or an offense in any jurisdiction which includes, at a minimum, all of the elements of said offenses, or who is listed on the Sex Offender Registry shall work in any agency or instrumentality of the government of Guam.

**EMPLOYMENT
MEDICAL
EXAMINATION**

All applicants accepting employment must undergo a medical examination and be declared by a physician as capable of performing the duties of the position being hired for.

WORK ELIGIBILITY

When offered a position, you will be required to provide proof of identity and eligibility for employment in the United States as a condition of employment.

DRUG SCREENING

Applicants selected for an offered employment with the Government of Guam shall undergo and pass a mandatory drug test before being employed. This also applies to employees selected for a Testing Designated Position (TDP). Failure to submit or pass such drug test shall be grounds for rescinding the offer of appointment.
