Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))	For CM923-15: Sentenced to one (1) year imprisonment, with credit for time served, balance suspended; pay \$100.00 fine, plus court costs; perform fifty (50) hours of community served; placed on probation for two (2) years; CSFC assessment and follow all treatment recommendations.

For CF169-09:

As to the charge of Family Violence (As a 3rd Degree Felony), defendant is sentenced to three (3) years imprisonment at DOC with no more than one (1) year to be served, balance suspended;

Defendant shall pay a fine of two Hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) towards Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund. A payment plan may be arranged;

Defendant shall serve three (3) years parole upon release with the following recommended conditions:

- i. Defendant shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, Nathan Joseph Camacho Babauta;
- ii. Defendant shall perform one (100) hundred hours of community service at the direction of the Alternative Sentencing Office, which may be converted to a fine at the current minimum wage rate for hour;
- iii. Defendant shall report to Department of Mental Health and to successfully complete alcohol counseling program recommended by the court, and shall pay the fee for the program;
- iv. Attend and successfully complete Anger Management classes and shall pay any fees for the program;
- v. Defendant shall not associate with any felon known to him at felon;
- vi. Defendant shall not consume any alcoholic beverages;
- vii. Defendant shall not enter any establishment which sells primarily alcoholic beverages;
- viii. Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substance;
- ix. Defendant shall submit to random drug testing;
- x. Defendant shall not live in a residence where firearms are present, and shall stay away from firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer or use any firearm;
- xi. Defendant shall forfeit his Guam Firearm Identification Card and shall not reapply for another one;
- xii. All firearms must be removed from the defendant's residence and surrendered to the Parole Office until disposition of this case. Defendant is to surrender his firearms and FAID to the Parole Office. 18 USC §922 makes it unlawful for any for any person subject to an order for protection or convicted of a crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess or receive firearms or ammunition;
- xiii. Defendant shall permit parole officers to search his person and residence for firearms, alcohol or illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of parole;
- xiv. Defendant shall surrender his passport to the Parole Office;
- xv. Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the

Defendant shall abide any other reasonable conditions imposed by the Court of Parole Office. <p>Failure of the Defendant to follow all of his conditions of supervised parole may result to the revocation of his parole at which time the Parole Board may impose the remainder of his parole term in prison or the remainder of his original sentence as determined from the date of his conviction.</p>
