<p>Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))</p>	<p><u>For CF470-11:</u> That to the offenses of ADVANCE STALKING (As a 2nd Degree Felony) and VIOLATION OF COURT ORDER (As a Misdemeanor), the Defendant, DEVIN EDWIN CAMACHO is sentenced as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Defendant shall be sentenced to serve three (3) years incarceration at the Department of Corrections in Mangilao, with all but eighteen (18) months suspended, with credit for time served. B. Defendant shall pay a fine of Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00), plus Court costs. Defendant acknowledges that he has the ability to pay this fine. All or part of the fine imposed may be converted to community service hours, under the direction of the Adult Probation Office, at the current minimum wage rate per hour. C. Defendant shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of two (2) years, during which time the following conditions of probation shall be imposed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Defendant shall perform one hundred (100) hours of community service work under the direction of the Adult Probation Office. All or part of community service hours imposed may be converted to a fine at the current minimum wage rate per hour; ii. Defendant shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from the victim, [victim's name omitted]. Defendant shall NOT CONTACT the same, either in person, through a third party, including a family member or friend, by telephone, text message, electronic device, e-mail, and/or any other form of communication, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the victim; iii. Defendant shall stay away from the residence, dwelling, school, day care center, or place of employment of the victim, Frances Anne Calvo, or any other specified place, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the above specified places; iv. Defendant shall not attend any function and/or establishment, including family and/or social functions, if he knows or becomes aware that the victim, [victim's name omitted], will be present. Upon becoming aware of his presence, or planned presence, the Defendant shall immediately leave the function and/or establishment; v. Defendant shall not harass, threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, [victim's name omitted]; vi. Defendant shall submit to [victim's name omitted], a written letter of apology for his actions in this case; vii. Defendant may bring a motion to permit contact with [victim's name omitted], victim and mother of Defendant's child. The People may oppose such motion, and no
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	<p>contact will be permitted, without the consent of [victim's name omitted];</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">viii. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office;ix. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office to attend and successfully complete Anger Management classes, and shall pay the fee for the program;x. Defendant shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the Court for intake and assessment. The Defendant shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling and/or family counseling;xi. Defendant shall report to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse for an intake and a drug and alcohol assessment, and follow all treatment plans as may be recommended by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse drug and alcohol assessment counselor;xii. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms;xiii. Defendant shall not apply for, possess, or own a firearm identification card;xiv. Defendant shall surrender his passport and/or other travel documents, if any, to the Adult Probation Office;xv. Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division;xvi. Defendant shall comply with any Court orders entered against the Defendant, including orders of family Court or any other local or federal Court of competent jurisdiction;xvii. Defendant shall abide by any other reasonable conditions imposed by the Court or the Adult Probation Office; andxviii. Defendant shall obey all federal and local laws of Guam. <p>D. xxx</p> <p>E. Failure of the Defendant to follow all of his conditions of probation will result in a hearing to revoke probation at which time the Court may impose the maximum penalty allowable under the statute charged.</p>

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that as to the offense of **FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor)**, the Defendant, **DEVIN EDWIN CAMACHO**, is hereby sentenced as follows:

- A. That Defendant shall pay a **fine** of **One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)**, plus Court costs. All or part of the fine imposed may be converted to community service work at the current prevailing minimum wage rate, except for the Court costs;
- B. That Defendant shall be placed on **supervised probation** for a period of **two (2) years**, during which time the following terms and condition of probation shall be imposed:
 1. Defendant shall not harass, threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, **[victim's name omitted]**;
 2. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, or annoying, **[victim's name omitted]**, a family or household member, or any person named in the court;
 3. Defendant shall perform **one hundred (100) hours of community service work** during the Defendant's probationary term. All or part of the community service hours may be converted to a fine at the current prevailing wage rate;
 4. Defendant shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the court for intake and assessment. The Defendant shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling and family counseling;
 5. The Defendant shall comply with and pay fees to the Superior Court of Guam for Group Treatment through the Client Services and Family Counseling Division, Individual Counseling or Psychological Evaluation through the Client Services and Family Counseling Division, and the Domestic Abuse Project Workshop at the Alternative Sentencing Office, in compliance with the court's order;
 6. Defendant shall report to the Guam Behavioral Health and Welfare Center for an assessment by a qualified substance abuse counselor of Defendant's alcohol dependence and need for treatment, the Probation Office shall contact the counselor for their recommendations to the court, which may require Defendant to obtain appropriate treatment, that all costs for such assessment or treatment or both shall be borne by Defendant at the discretion of the court;
 7. Defendant must attend and complete and pay the \$200 tuition fee of an Alcohol Treatment Program as ordered by the court;
 8. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation

Office;

9. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, and shall not enter any establishments whose primary business is selling alcoholic beverages;
 10. Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances;
 11. Defendant shall forfeit his firearm identification card to the court and shall not reapply for another one. **18 U.S.C. § 922 makes it unlawful for any person subject to an order for protection or convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition;**
 12. Defendant shall not live in any residence where firearms are present and shall stay away from all firearms and other deadly weapons, and under no circumstances is he to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms;
 13. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Adult Probation Office;
 14. Defendant shall permit the probation officers and peace officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcoholic beverages and illegal controlled substances, at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;
 15. Defendant shall not associate with any felons known to him as felons;
 16. Defendant shall turn in his passport and/or other travel documents to the Clerk of Court;
 17. Defendant shall comply with any court orders entered against the Defendant, including orders of family court or any other local or federal court of competent jurisdiction;
 18. Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division;
 19. Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws; and
 20. Defendant shall comply with any other condition imposed by the Court or the Adult Probation Office.
- C. Failure of the Defendant to follow all of his conditions of probation will result in a hearing to revoke probation at which time the court may impose the maximum sentence allowable under the statute charged as specified in paragraph 2 of the agreement.

Sent 30 days DOC, suspended, with credit for time served; pay \$500.00 fine, plus court costs; pay full restitution; placed on a supervised probation for 1 year; stay away from victim; forfeit firearms and FAID;

	perform fifty (50) hours of community service; report to CSFC; report once a month to probation; shall not leave Guam; and obey all laws.
