<p>Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))</p>	<p>CF229-14: For the First charge of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a 3rd Degree Felony), three (3) years imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, with no time suspended, with credit for time served.</p> <p>Defendant shall be held liable for full restitution, if any, to the victim, <i>(victim's name omitted)</i>, the amount to be determined at a restitution hearing. Defendant shall pay said restitution in monthly installments to be arranged by the Adult Probation Office and shall pay it in full prior to the termination of his probationary period;</p> <p>During Defendant's term of incarceration, the Defendant shall not contact <i>(victim's name omitted)</i>, but she may contact him and visit him in custody;</p> <p>Defendant shall be placed on three (3) years parole. The following conditions are recommended:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">i. Defendant shall stay away, directly and indirectly from the victim, <i>(victim's name omitted)</i>, unless she initiates contact.ii. Defendant shall live at the residence of the victim, <i>(victim's name omitted)</i>;iii. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying, or molesting <i>(victim's name omitted)</i>, a family or household member, or any person named in the court <i>including any and all witnesses</i>;iv. Defendant shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, <i>(victim's name omitted)</i>;v. <u>The Defendant shall register on the Family violence registry as required by law;</u>vi. Defendant shall stay away from all felons known to him as felons;vii. Defendant shall report to the Parole Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Parole Office;viii. Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances;ix. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms;x. Defendant shall forfeit his firearm identification card to the court and shall not reapply for another one. 18 U.S.C. § 922 makes it unlawful for any person subject to an order for protection or convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition;xi. Defendant shall not apply for, possess, or own a firearm identification card;xii. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Parole Office;
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- xiii. Defendant shall permit Parole officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of parole;
- xiv. Defendant shall comply with any other condition imposed by the court of the Parole Office;
- xv. Defendant shall comply with any court orders entered against the Defendant, including orders of family court or any other local or federal court of competent jurisdiction;
- xvi. Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws; and,
- xvii. Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the court or Parole Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, General Crimes Division.

Defendant shall report to the Parole Services Division within forty-eight (48) hours of his release from incarceration for intake and processing.

CM83-12:

For the offence of **FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor)** and **ASSAULT (As a Misdemeanor)**, one (1) year imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, with credit for time served, all but six (6) months direct, the remaining balance suspended;

That as to the violation of Probation in Criminal Case No. CF91-11, the People imposed six (6) months direct imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, the Defendant shall serve direct imprisonment on paragraph (a) and (b) concurrently.

Defendant shall pay a fine of four hundred dollars (\$400), a separate fine from Criminal Case No. CF91-11, plus Court costs. All or part of the fine imposed may be converted to community service work under the direction of the Alternative Sentencing Office at a minimum rate of per hour;

Defendant shall be held liable for full restitution, **if any**, to victim, of his actions, in an amount to be determined by Court at a restitution hearing. Defendant shall pay said restitution in monthly installments to be arranged by the Adult Probation Office and shall pay it in full prior to the termination of his probation;

Defendant shall be placed on two (2) years supervised probation, during which time the following conditions of probation shall be imposed;

- i. Defendant shall not contact the victim, (*victim's name omitted*), in person, through a third party, by telephone, or by letter, **contact with the victim can be reinstated after four (4) months supervised probation or completion of Client Services and Family Counseling Division treatment, whichever occurs first;**
- ii. Defendant is prohibited from harassing, annoying,

	<p>telephoning, contacting, or otherwise communicating with <i>(victim's name omitted)</i> or specified witness or witnesses, either directly or indirectly;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">iii. Defendant shall stay away from <i>(victim's name omitted)</i> and shall not contact same either in person, through a third-party, by telephone or by letter;iv. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying, or molesting, <i>(victim's name omitted)</i>, a family or household member, or any person named in the court order;v. Defendant shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the court for intake and assessment. The Defendant shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling, and family counseling. Client Services and Family Counseling Division may also, if determined to be appropriate, refer the Defendant, to the Domestic Abuse Project Workshop administered through the Probation Office of the Superior Court of Guam, and the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse for intake and assessment, and any other agencies or organizations as deemed appropriate;vi. Defendant may not possess, use, and consume any alcoholic beverages and illegal controlled substances;vii. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol testing at the request of the Probation Office. Failure to submit to testing shall be considered a violation;viii. The Probation Officers are authorized to search the Defendant's residence, vehicle, and person anytime for any alcohol;ix. Defendant is to report to the Probation Office once a month in person;x. Defendant shall obey all laws of Guam; andxi. <u>Defendant shall write a letter of apology to his victim, <i>(victim's name omitted)</i>;</u>xii. Defendant shall abide by any other reasonable conditions imposed by the court or the probation office. <p>Should the defendant complete the above conditions before the expiration of the two (2) years supervised probationary period, the defendant will be placed on unsupervised probation for the remaining portion of his probation period;</p> <p>Failure of the Defendant to follow all of his conditions of probation will result in a hearing to revoke probation at which time the court may impose the maximum penalty allowable under the statute charged;</p>
