Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))	<u>CM109-15:</u> That as to the charge of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor) , the Defendant shall be sentenced to <i>one (1) year</i> imprisonment at the Department of Corrections in Mangilao, <i>all suspended, with credit for time served</i> ; Defendant shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of <i>two (2) years</i> , with the following

recommended terms and conditions of probation, to run concurrent with the Defendant's terms of probation in CM861-14:

- i. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office;
 - ii. Defendant shall report to Client Services & Family Counseling Divisions for intake and assessment, including drug and alcohol assessment, and shall comply with all treatment recommendations and requirements including paying all related costs of treatment;
 - iii. Defendant shall undergo and successfully complete parenting classes;
 - iv. Defendant shall undergo and successfully complete alcohol treatment at New Beginnings;
 - v. Defendant shall make good faith efforts to obtain and maintain legitimate employment effective immediately, and that the Adult Probation Office shall monitor Defendant's progress on a monthly basis;
 - vi. Defendant shall not harass, threaten, physically strike, or injure (*victim's name omitted*), or any other family or household member. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from molesting (*victim's name omitted*) or any other family or household member;
 - vii. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverage or any illegal drugs or controlled substance or intoxicants;
 - viii. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearm. It is a violation of federal law under 18 USC §922 for any person subject to an order of protection or convicted of a crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition, except as required during the course of duty for military or law enforcement employment pursuant to 18 USC §925;
 - ix. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol or drug testing;
 - x. Defendant shall permit probation officers and other peace officers to search the Defendant's person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs or controlled substance at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;
 - xi. Defendant shall turn in his passport, and/or other travel documents to the Adult Probation Office Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division;
 - xii. Defendant shall comply with any other conditions imposed by the Court or Adult Probation Office; and
- Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws.

CM200-04: 1)That as to the charge of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor), the Defendant is sentenced to pay a fine of (\$500) towards the Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund and/or the fine may be

converted to community service hours at a rate of \$5.15 per hour;

2) Defendant shall be placed on 2 years of supervised probation, provided that the Defendant completes the following conditions:

3) That during his 2-year probationary period, the Defendant, in addition to the standard conditions of probation, shall abide by and complete the following terms and conditions:

- i. That Defendant shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, (*victim's name omitted*);
- ii. That Defendant shall perform 100 hours of community service work under the direction of the Alternative Sentencing Office during the 2 year supervised probationary period. That Defendant shall receive 2 hours credit of community service work for each 1 hour of counseling completed by Defendant;
- iii. That Defendant shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the Court for intake and assessment. Defendant shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling and /or family counseling. Defendant may seek an approved equivalent of such services and treatment elsewhere on Guam;
- iv. That Defendant shall undergo and successfully complete the Anger Management classed through Sanctuary House should the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the Court determine that Defendant does not require counseling;
- v. That Defendant shall report to the Dept of Mental Health and Substance Abuse for an intake and a drug and alcohol assessment, and follow all treatment plan as may be recommended by the Dept of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Drug and Alcohol Assessment Counselor. Defendant may seek an approved equivalent of such services and treatment elsewhere on Guam;
- vi. That Defendant shall pay for any alcohol fees incurred;
- vii. That Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office;
- viii. That Defendant shall seek and attempt to maintain full-time legitimate employment, effective immediately, and that the Adult Probation Office shall monitor Defendant's progress on a monthly basis;
- ix. That Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, and shall not enter any establishments whose primary business is the sale of alcoholic beverages;
- x. That Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances;
- xi. That Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry transfer, or use any firearms;
- xii. That Defendant shall forfeit his firearm's identification card to the court, if he possesses one, and shall not reapply for another one;
- xiii. That Defendant shall not apply for , possess, or own a firearm identification card;
- xiv. All firearms must be removed from the Defendant's residence and

	<p>surrendered to the Probation Office until disposition of this case. Defendant is to surrender his firearms and firearms identification card to the Probation Office. 18 U.S.C. §922 makes it unlawful for any person subject to an order of protection against harassing, stalking or threatening an intimate partner, or child or an intimate party; or who has been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence, to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition;</p> <p>xv. That Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Adult Probation Office;</p> <p>xvi. That Defendant shall permit probation and police officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcohol and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;</p> <p>xvii. That Defendant shall comply with any other conditions imposed by the Court or the Adult Probation Office;</p> <p>xviii. That Defendant shall comply with any court orders entered against the Defendant, including order of family court or any other local or federal court of competent jurisdiction;</p> <p>xix. That Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws; and,</p> <p>xx. That Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, General Crimes Division.</p> <p>xxi. That failure of Defendant to follow all of the conditions of his supervised probation will result in a hearing to revoke probation at which time the court may impose the maximum sentence allowable under the statute charged, which in the instant case for the charge is 1 year imprisonment.</p>
