<p><b>Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))</b></p>	<p><b><u>For CM140-16:</u></b>  <b>WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED</b>, that as to the offense of <b>FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor)</b>, the Defendant, <b>BARCARDI LUBIAN GALVEZ</b>, is hereby sentenced as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Defendant is sentenced to serve one (1) year imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, with credit for time served, balance suspended, to run concurrent with CF650-14;</li> <li>B. Defendant shall be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year, concurrent with his probation in CF650-14, and shall be subject to the terms and conditions of probation previously ordered;</li> <li>C. Until further order of the court, defendant shall stay away from <b>[victim's name omitted]</b> and shall have no contact with her, and shall not harass, threaten or commit acts of family violence against her;</li> <li>D. Defendant shall pay court costs;</li> <li>E. As to the charge of Harassment as a petty misdemeanor, defendant articulated sufficient facts to support a finding of guilt as to that charge. However, defendant argued that this offense merged with the Family Violence charge within the meaning of 9 GCA § 1.22, and that the same statute provides that he may not be convicted of more than one offense.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>For CF650-14:</u></b>  <b>WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED</b>, that as to the offense of <b>FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor)</b>, the Defendant, <b>BARCARDI LUBIAN GALVEZ</b>, is hereby sentenced as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Serve <b>one (1) year imprisonment</b>, with <b>all but ninety (90) days suspended</b>, at the Department of Corrections, with credit for time served;</li> <li>b. Defendant shall be placed on supervised <b>probation</b> for a period of <b>two (2) years</b>, during which time the following terms and condition of probation shall be imposed: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Defendant shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from victim, <b>[victim's name omitted]</b>. The Defendant shall <b>NOT CONTACT</b> the victim either in person, through a third-party, by telephone, text message, electronic device, e-mail, letter, or any other form of communication, including a family member or friend;</li> <li>2. Defendant shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of <b>[victim's name omitted]</b>;</li> <li>3. Defendant shall stay away from the residence, dwelling,</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

	<p>school, day care center, or place of employment of [victim's name omitted], or any other specified place, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the above specified places;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>4. Defendant shall not attend any function, including family and social functions, or enter any establishment, if he knows or becomes aware that [victim's name omitted] will be present. Upon becoming aware of the victim's presence, or planned presence, the Defendant shall immediately leave the function or establishment;</li><li>5. Defendant shall not harass, threaten, physically strike, or injure [victim's name omitted];</li><li>6. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, or annoying [victim's name omitted], a family or household member, or any person named in the court;</li><li>7. Defendant shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the court for intake and assessment. The Defendant shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling and family counseling;</li><li>8. Defendant shall comply with and pay fees to the Superior Court of Guam for Group Treatment through the Client Services and Family Counseling Division, Individual Counseling or Psychological Evaluation through the Client Services and Family Counseling Division, and the Domestic Abuse Project Workshop at the Alternative Sentencing Office, in compliance with the court's order;</li><li>9. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office;</li><li>10. Defendant shall seek and attempt to maintain full-time legitimate employment, effective immediately, and that the Adult Probation Office shall monitor Defendant's progress on a monthly basis;</li><li>11. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, and shall not enter any establishments whose primary business is selling alcoholic beverages;</li><li>12. Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances;</li><li>13. Defendant shall forfeit his firearm identification card to the court and shall not reapply for another one. <b>18 U.S.C. § 922 makes it unlawful for any person subject to an order for protection or convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition;</b></li></ol>
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	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>14. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Adult Probation Office;</li> <li>15. Defendant shall permit the probation officers and peace officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcoholic beverages and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;</li> <li>16. Defendant shall not associate with any felons known to him as felons;</li> <li>17. Defendant shall turn in his passport and/or other travel documents to the Clerk of Court;</li> <li>18. Defendant shall comply with any court orders entered against the Defendant, including orders of family court or any other local or federal court of competent jurisdiction;</li> <li>19. Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division;</li> <li>20. Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws; and</li> <li>21. Defendant shall comply with any other condition imposed by the Court or the Adult Probation Office.</li> </ol> <p><b><u>For CM347-00:</u></b> Sentenced to 25 days incarceration at the Department of Corrections, to run concurrent with CM532-99; upon release, he shall be placed on a one (1) year parole; perform 100 hours of community service; report to Client Service and Family Counseling; undergo drug and alcohol assessment; pay fine imposed; must report to Parole Service once a month; stay away from firearms; forfeit FAID; obey all laws; not to leave Guam.</p> <p><b><u>For CM532-99:</u></b> Sentenced to 25 days incarceration at the Department of Corrections, to run concurrent with CM347-00; upon release, he shall be placed on a one (1) year parole; perform 100 hours of community service; report to Client Service and Family Counseling; undergo drug and alcohol assessment; pay fine imposed; must report to Parole Service once a month; stay away from firearms; forfeit FAID; obey all laws; not to leave Guam.</p>
