That as to the First Charge, Count One of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a 3rd degree Felony), in Criminal Case No. CM211-14, the of Defendant shall be sentenced to serve three (3) years imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, all but six (6) months suspended, with credit for time served. The sentence shall include a special parole term of not less than three (3) years in addition to such term of imprisonment.</p> <p>b. That as to the charge through an Information to VIOLATION OF A COURT ORDER (As a Misdemeanor), in Criminal Case No. CM339-14, the Defendant shall serve one (1) year at the Department of Corrections, all suspended, with credit for time served; The sentence imposed under this Section shall run consecutive to any sentence already imposed on the offender for any other offense at the time he is sentenced under this Section.</p> <p>c. Defendant shall pay a court costs;</p> <p>d. Defendant shall be held liable for full restitution to the victims, the amount to be determined at a restitution hearing. Defendant shall pay said restitution in monthly installments to be arranged by the Parole Office and shall pay it in full prior to the termination of his Parole period;</p> <p>e. During the Defendant's term of incarceration, the Defendant shall not contact (<i>victim's names omitted</i>) in person, by telephone, in writing, and/or through a third party, including a family member or friend;</p> <p>f. Defendant shall be sentenced to three (3) years imprisonment at the Department of Corrections. Upon the Defendant's release, he shall be placed on parole for three (3) years with the following recommended conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Defendant shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from the business establishment, Pacific Gardens Apts, Dededo; ii. Defendant shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from the victims, (<i>victim's names omitted</i>) and or any witnesses. The Defendant shall not contact the same by telephone, in writing, and/or through a third party, including a family member or friend; iii. Defendant shall stay away from the residence, dwelling, school, day care center, or place of employment of the victims, (<i>victim's names omitted</i>), or any other specified place, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the above specified places; iv. Defendant shall not attend any function and/or establishment, including family and/or social functions, if he knows or becomes aware that the victims, (<i>victim's names omitted</i>), will be present. Upon becoming aware of the victim's presence, or planned presence, the Defendant shall immediately leave the function and/or establishment; v. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying, or molesting (<i>victim's names omitted</i>), a family or household member, or any person named in the court including any and all witnesses; vi. Defendant shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure the victims, (<i>victim's names omitted</i>);

Defendant shall report to the Guam Behavioral Health and wellness Center for an intake and a drug and alcohol assessment, and follow all treatment plans as may be recommended by the Guam Behavioral Health and wellness Center and alcohol assessment counselor;</p> <p>viii. Defendant shall report to the Parole Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Parole Office;</p> <p>ix. Defendant shall seek and attempt to maintain full-time legitimate employment, effective immediately, and that the Parole Office shall monitor Defendant's progress on a monthly basis;</p> <p>x. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages;</p> <p>xi. Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances;</p> <p>xii. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms;</p> <p>xiii. Defendant shall not apply for, possess, or own a firearm identification card;</p> <p>xiv. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Parole;</p> <p>xv. Defendant shall permit parole officers or any law officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcohol and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of parole;</p> <p>xvi. Defendant shall turn in his passport and/or other travel documents to the Parole Office;</p> <p>xvii. Defendant shall comply with any other condition imposed by the court or the Parole Office;</p> <p>xviii. Defendant shall comply with any court orders entered against the Defendant, including orders of family court or any other local or federal court of competent jurisdiction;</p> <p>xix. Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws; and,</p> <p>xx. Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Parole Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division.</p> <p>g. Defendant shall report to the Parole Services Division within forty-eight (48) hours of his release from incarceration for intake and processing.</p> <p>h. Upon the court's acceptance of Defendant's plea of guilty and sentencing of the Defendant in accordance with the terms of the plea agreement herein, the People will move to dismiss the remaining charge of First Charge, Count of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a 3rd Degree Felony), Second Charge of CRIMINAL MISCHIEF (as a 3rd Degree Felony) and Third Charge of CRIMINAL MISCHIEF (As a Misdemeanor), in Criminal Case No. CF211-14, and First Charge of AGGRAVATED ASSAULT (as a 3rd Degree Felony), Second Charge of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor), Third Charge of ASSAULT (As a Misdemeanor) and Fourth Charge of DISORDERLY CONDUCT (As a Petty Misdemeanor), in Criminal Case No.</p>
