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| <p>Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))</p> | <p><u>For CF542-12:</u> Sentenced to one (1) year imprisonment, with credit for time served; pay \$500 fine plus court costs; place on two (2) years of supervised probation, provided that the Defendant complete the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying or molesting [victim's name omitted], a family or household member, or any person named in the court including any and all witnesses; - Shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, [victim's name omitted]; - Shall stay away from all felons known to him as felons; - Shall perform two hundred (200) hours of community service work under the direction of the Probation Office during the two (2) years supervised probationary period; - Shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the court for intake and assessment. The Defendant shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling and/or family counseling; - Shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office; - Shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages; - Shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances; shall stay away from all firearms, or any kind of deadly weapons, and is not to possess, carry, transfer or use any firearms; - Shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Adult Probation; - Shall permit probation officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcohol and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation; - Shall comply with any other condition imposed by the court of competent jurisdiction; - Shall obey all local and federal laws; and - Shall not leave Guam without the approval of the court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, General Crimes Division. <p><u>CM142-14:</u> Sentenced to one (1) year imprisonment, all by thirty (30) days suspended, with credit for time served; pay all court costs; pay full restitution; place on parole from one (1) year with the following recommended conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying, or molesting [victim's name omitted], a family or household member, or any person names in the court including any and all witnesses; - Shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, [victim's name omitted]; |
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| | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the court for intake and assessment. Shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling, group counseling and/or family counseling; - Shall report to the Parole Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Parole Office; - Shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages; - Shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances; - Shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms; - Shall forfeit his firearm identification card to the court and shall not reapply for another one. 18 U.S.C. § 922 makes it unlawful for any person subject to an order for protection or convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition; - Shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Parole; - Shall permit parole officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcohol and illegal controlled substances at any time such as search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of parole; |
