Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))	a. That as to the charge in CM1134-14 of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor), the Defendant shall be sentenced to one (1) year imprisonment at the Department of Corrections in Mangilao, all suspended, with credit for time served;

- b. Defendant agrees to have his deferred status in CM56-14 revoked, and that judgment of guilty to the charge of one count of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor) in CM56-14 entered;
(DEFERRED STATUS on this matter was revoked as a result of CM1134-14)**
- c. As to the Defendant's revoked deferred status in CM56-14, the Defendant shall be sentenced to one (1) year imprisonment at the Department of Corrections in Mangilao, all suspended, with credit for time served;
- d. Both sentences to run concurrently with each other;
- e. Defendant shall pay a Two Hundred Dollar (\$200.00) fine, plus court costs. Defendant acknowledges that he has the ability to pay this fine. All or part of the fine imposed may be worked off through community service at the current minimum wage rate per hour;
- f. Defendant shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of two (2) years, with the following recommended terms and conditions of probation:
- i. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office;
 - ii. Defendant shall report to Client Services & Family Counseling Divisions for intake and assessment, including drug and alcohol assessment, and shall comply with all treatment recommendations and requirements including paying all related costs of treatment;
 - iii. Defendant shall not harass, threaten, physically strike, or injure (*victim's name omitted*), or any other family or household member. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing or molesting, (*victim's name omitted*), or any other family or household member;
 - iv. Defendant shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from (*victim's name omitted*), and shall not contact the same either in person, through a third party, including a family members or friends, by telephone, text message, electronic device, e-mail, and/or any other form of communication, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of (*victim's name omitted*);
 - v. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverage or any illegal drugs or controlled substance or intoxicants;
 - vi. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearm. It is a violation of federal law under 18 USC §922 for any person subject to an order of protection or convicted of a crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition, except as required during the course of duty for military or law enforcement employment pursuant to 18 USC §925;
 - vii. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol or drug testing;
 - viii. Defendant shall permit probation officers and other

	<p>peace officers to search the Defendant's person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs or controlled substance at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;</p> <p>ix. Defendant shall turn in his passport, and/or other travel documents to the Adult Probation Office;</p> <p>x. Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division;</p> <p>xi. Defendant shall comply with any other conditions imposed by the Court or Adult Probation Office; and</p> <p>xii. Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws.</p> <p>g. Failure of the Defendant to follow all of his conditions of probation may result in a hearing to revoke probation at which time the Court may impose upon the Defendant any sentence that might have been imposed originally for the offense he is pleading guilty to; and</p> <p>h. Upon the Court's acceptance of Defendant's plea of guilty and sentencing of the Defendant in accordance with the terms of this plea agreement, the People will agree to dismiss the remaining charges against the Defendant, as contained in the Magistrate's Complaints filed in both cases.</p>
