

<p>Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))</p>	<p>For CF0316-98: Sent 30 days DOC; 3 yrs probation; counseling; drug & alcohol assessment; domestic workshop; stay away from victim.</p> <p>For CM0709-10: That for the offense of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor), the Defendant is sentenced as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Defendant is to serve <i>one (1) year</i> imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, <i>serve ninety (90) days direct-time, the remaining balance suspended, with credit for time served;</i> b. Defendant shall pay a fine of <i>five hundred dollars (\$500.00)</i>, plus Court costs. Defendant acknowledges that he has the ability to pay this fine; c. Defendant shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of <i>two (2) years</i>, during which time the following terms and conditions of probation shall be imposed: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Defendant shall perform <i>one hundred (100) hours</i> of community service work under the direction of the Alternative Sentencing Office; ii. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation; iii. Defendant shall not harass, threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, [victim's name omitted]; iv. Defendant shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the Court for intake and assessment. The Defendant shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling and/or family counseling; v. Defendant shall report to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse for an intake and a drug and alcohol assessment, and follow all treatment plans as may be recommended by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Drug and Alcohol Assessment Counselor; vi. Defendant shall undergo and successfully complete anger management counseling; vii. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, and shall not enter any establishments whose primary business is the sale of alcoholic beverages; viii. Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances; ix. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms; x. Defendant shall forfeit the firearm, the ammunition clip, and the rounds of ammunition confiscated in this case to the Guam Police Department for its use, sale, or destruction, if any; xi. That the Defendant shall forfeit his firearm's identification
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card to the court, if he possesses one, and shall not reapply for another one. **18 U.S.C. § 922 makes it unlawful for any person subject to an order for protection or convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition;**

- xii. Defendant shall not apply for, possess, or own a firearm identification card;
- xiii. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Adult Probation Office;
- xiv. Defendant shall permit probation and police officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcohol and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;
- xv. Defendant shall turn in his passport, and/or other travel documents to the Clerk of Court, if any;
- xvi. Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division;
- xvii. Defendant shall comply with any other conditions imposed by the Court or the Adult Probation Office;
- xviii. Defendant shall comply with any court orders entered against the Defendant, including orders of family court or any other local or federal court of competent jurisdiction; and
- xix. Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws.

For CM0245-14: As to the charge of *two counts* of **FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor)**, the Defendant shall be sentenced to *one (1) year* imprisonment, for each count, at the Department of Corrections in Mangilao. Sentences to *run concurrent, all suspended, with credit for time served*;

- a. Defendant shall pay a *Two Hundred Dollar (\$200.00)* fine, plus court costs. Defendant acknowledges that he has the ability to pay this fine. All or part of the fine imposed, except court costs, may be worked off through community service under the direction of the Adult Probation Office at the prevailing minimum wage rate per hour;
- b. Defendant shall be placed on a supervised probation for a period of *two (2) years*, with the following recommended terms and conditions of probation:
 - i. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office;
 - ii. Defendant shall report to Client Services & Family

	<p>Counseling Divisions for intake and assessment, including drug and alcohol assessment, and shall comply with all treatment recommendations and requirements including paying all related treatment and court costs. Defendant further agrees to attend all court hearings, report to probation as required, and attend and participate in all treatment sessions and assigned classes;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">iii. Defendant shall not harass, threaten, physically strike, or injure [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted], or victims' household or family members;iv. Defendant shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted], or victims' household or family members, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted]. The Defendant shall not contact them either in person, through a third party, including a family member or friend, by telephone, text message, electronic device, e-mail, letter, or any other form of communication;v. Defendant shall stay away from the residence, dwelling, school, day care center, or place of employment of [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted], or any other specified place, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the above specified places;vi. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverage, or any illegal controlled substance or intoxicants;vii. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearm, including Air Soft weapons/pistols/rifles. Defendant shall surrender any and all firearms, firearm identifications, and firearm permits in the Defendant's control and/or possession to Adult Probation Services until disposition of this case, and shall not live in any residence where firearms are present;viii. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing;ix. Defendant shall permit probation officers and peace officers to search the Defendant's person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcoholic beverages and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;x. Defendant shall perform <i>one hundred (100) hours</i> of community service under the direction of the Adult Probation Office, which may be converted to a fine at the current minimum wage rate per hour;xi. Defendant shall turn in his passport, and/or other travel documents to the Adult Probation Office, if any;

Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division; xiii. Defendant shall comply with any other conditions imposed by the Adult Probation Office; xiv. Defendant shall comply with any Court orders entered against the Defendant, including orders of other local or federal court of competent jurisdiction; and xv. Defendant shall obey all local and federal laws. <p>c. Defendant shall abide by any other reasonable conditions imposed by the Court; and</p> <p>d. Failure of the Defendant to follow all of his conditions of probation may result in a hearing to revoke probation at which time the Court may impose upon the Defendant any sentence that might have been imposed originally for the offense he is pleading guilty to.</p>
