Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))	For the Charge of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a 3rd Degree Felony) , in CF399-14 , three (3) years imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, all but nine (9) months suspended, with credit for time served.

For the **Fifth charge, Count One of VIOLATION OF COURT ORDER (As a Misdemeanor)**, in **CF399-14**, ONE (1) YEAR AT THE Department of Corrections, served all suspended, with credit time; *The sentence imposed under this Section shall run concurrent to any sentence already imposed on the offender for any other offense at the time he is sentenced under this Section.*

For the **Charge of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor)**, in **CM485-14**, one (1) year at the Department of Corrections, served all suspended, with credit for time served. The sentence pursuant to this plea agreement shall include a special parole term of not less than three (3) years in addition to such term of imprisonment. *The sentence imposed under this Section shall run concurrent to any sentence already imposed on the offender for any other offense at the time he is sentenced under this Section.*

Defendant shall pay court costs;

Defendant shall be held liable for full restitution, if any, to the victims, the amount to be determined at a restitution hearing. Defendant shall pay said restitution in monthly installments to be arranged by the Parole Office and shall pay it in full prior to the termination of his Parole period;

During Defendant's term of incarceration, the Defendant shall not contact (*victim names omitted*) in person, by telephone, in writing, and/or through a third party, including a family member or friend;

Defendant shall be sentenced to three (3) years imprisonment at the Department of Corrections with all but nine (9) months of said term suspended. Upon the Defendant's release, he shall be placed on parole for three (3) years with the following recommended conditions:

- i. Defendant shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from the victims, (*victim names omitted*), and/or any witnesses. The Defendant shall not contact the same by telephone, in writing, and /or through a third party, including a family member or friend;
- ii. Defendant shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the victims, (*victim names omitted*);
- iii. Defendant shall stay away from the residence, dwelling, school, day care center, or place of employment of the victims, (*victim names omitted*), or any other specified place, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the above specified places;
- iv. Defendant shall not attend any function and/or establishment, including family and/or social functions, if he knows or becomes aware that the victims, (*victim names omitted*), will be present. Upon becoming aware of the

	<p>victim's presence, or planned presence, the Defendant shall immediately leave the function and/or establishment;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">v. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying, or molesting (<i>victim names omitted</i>), a family or household member, or any person named in the court including any and all witnesses;vi. Defendant shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure the victims, (<i>victim names omitted</i>);vii. Defendant shall stay away from all felons known to him as felons;viii. Defendant shall report to the Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center oral for an intake and a drug and alcohol assessment, and follow all treatment plans as may be recommended by the Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center drug and alcohol assessment counselor;ix. Defendant shall report to the Parole Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Parole Office;x. Defendant shall seek and attempt to maintain full-time legitimate employment, effective immediately, and that the Parole Office shall monitor Defendant's progress on a monthly basis;xi. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, and shall not enter any establishments whose primary business is the sale of alcoholic beverages;xii. Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances;xiii. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms;xiv. Defendant shall forfeit his firearm identification card to the court and shall not reapply for another one. 18 U.S.C. § 922 makes it unlawful for any person subject to an order for protection or convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition;xv. Defendant shall not apply for, possess, or own a firearm identification card;xvi. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Parole;xvii. Defendant shall permit parole officers and Law Enforcement Officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcohol and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of parole;xviii. Defendant shall turn in his passport and/or other travel documents to the Clerk of Court;xix. Defendant shall comply with any other condition imposed by the court or the Parole Office;

Defendant shall report to the Parole Services Division within forty-eight (48) hours of his release from incarceration for intake and processing.
