That as to the charge of ASSAULT (As a Misdemeanor), Defendant shall be sentence to two (2) years imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, with credit for time served, all but six (6) months suspended. 2. That as to the charge of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor). Defendant shall be sentence to one (1) year imprisonment at the Department of Corrections, with credit for time served, all suspended; 3. That as to the charges of ASSAULT (As a Misdemeanor) and FAMILY VIOLENCE

(As a Misdemeanor), the Defendant shall serve both sentences concurrently, total of six (6) months direct;

4. Defendant shall pay a fine of two hundred (\$200) dollars, plus court costs. A payment plan may be arranged with the Adult Probation Office. All or part of the fine imposed may be converted to community service work under the direction of the Alternative Sentencing Office at a minimum rate per hour;

5. Defendant shall be held liable for full restitution, if any, of his actions, in an amount to be determined by Court at a restitution hearing. Defendant shall pay said restitution in monthly installments to be arranged by the Adult Probation Office and shall pay it in full prior to the termination of his probation; However, in the event restitution is not paid by the expiration of probation, the obligation for restitution shall survive

6. Defendant shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of two (2) years, during which time the following terms and condition of probation shall be imposed:

- A. Defendant shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure (*victim's names omitted*);
- B. Defendant shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying, or molesting (*victim's name omitted*), a family or household member, or any person named in the court including any and all witnesses;
- C. Defendant shall write a letter of apology to both victims;
- D. Defendant shall perform fifty (50) hours of community service work under the direction of the Adult Probation during the Defendant's two (2) years.
- E. Defendant shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the court for intake and assessment. The Defendant shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling and family counseling;
- F. Defendant shall report to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse for an intake and a drug and alcohol assessment, and follow all treatment plans as may be recommended by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse drug and alcohol assessment counselor;
- G. Defendant shall attend and successfully complete the Anger Management Program administered by the Adult Probation Office;
- H. Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Officer once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation;
- I. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages;
- J. Defendant shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances;
- K. Defendant shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms;
- L. Defendant shall not live in a residence that has firearms;
- M. Defendant shall not apply for, possess, or own a firearm identification card;
- N. Defendant shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Adult Probation Officer;

7. Defendant shall permit the probation officers to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcohol and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;

- P. Defendant shall turn in his passport and/or other travel documents to the Clerk of Court;
- Q. Defendant shall comply with any court orders entered against the

Defendant shall not leave Guam without the approval of the court or Adult Probation, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, General Crimes Division;</p> <p>S.
