

Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))	For CM0831-13: Sentenced to one (1) year imprisonment for each count, to be served concurrently, or direct time of one (1) year imprisonment; pay \$500 fine; pay restitution; place on parole for one (1) year upon release, with the following recommended terms and conditions of parole:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Stay away from [victim's name omitted] and her children; - Perform 100 hours community service; - Assessment by GBHWC; - Obey all laws of Guam. <p><u>For CF0191-14:</u> Sentenced to three (3) years imprisonment, all but twelve (12) months suspended, with credit for time served. Sentence to run concurrent to any sentence already imposed for any other offense; pay \$100.00 fine, convertible to community service, plus court costs; pay restitution, if any, which may be paid in installment; not to contact [victim's name omitted], [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted]; to be placed on parole for two (2) years upon release, under the following terms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Stay away and not to contact [victim's name omitted], [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted]; - Not to attend any function or enter any establishment where [victim's name omitted], [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted] are present; - Refrain from threatening to commit acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying or molesting [victim's name omitted], [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted], or any other family or household members; not to threaten, physically strike or injure [victim's name omitted], [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted]; - To be placed on the Family Violence registry; - Write letter of apology to [victim's name omitted], [victim's name omitted] and [victim's name omitted]; - Stay away from felons known to him as felons; - Perform community service; - Report to GBHWC for assessment, and shall follow all treatment recommendations; - Report to parole officer once a month in person; - Seek and attempt to maintain full-time employment; - Not to possess or consume alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs. Not to enter establishment selling alcoholic beverages; - Stay away and to possess, carry, transfer or use any firearms. Forfeit any firearm, FAID and ammunitions; - Submit to random alcohol and drug testing; - Permit parole officers to search his person, vehicle or residence for alcohol, illegal drugs or firearms; - Comply with court orders. Obey all laws; and - Not to leave Guam.
