Punishment prescribed for each offense (30.200(c)(4))	For CF177-12: Sentenced to three (3) years imprisonment, all suspended, but credit for time served; pay fine of \$500, plus Court costs; pay full restitution, if any, to the victim; place on three (3) years

supervised probation, provided that the Defendant completes the following conditions:

- Shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from the victim, [victim's name omitted] and shall not contact the same by telephone, in writing, and/or through a third party, including a family member or friend;
- Shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the victim, [victim's name omitted];
- Shall stay away from the residence, dwelling, school, day care center, or place of employment of the victim, [victim's name omitted], or any other specified place, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of the above specified places;
- Shall not attend any function and/or establishment, including family and/or social functions, if he knows or becomes aware that the victim, [victim's name omitted], will be present. Upon becoming aware of the victim's presence, or planned presence, the Defendant shall immediately leave the function and/or establishment;
- Shall not threaten, physically strike, or injure the victim, [victim's name omitted];
- Shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, or molesting [victim's name omitted], a family or household member, or any person named in the court order;
- Shall report to the Client Services and Family Counseling Division of the Court for intake and assessment. Shall follow all treatment recommendations including psychological evaluation, psychiatric evaluation, drug and alcohol evaluation, individual counseling, group counseling and/or family counseling;
- Shall undergo and successfully complete the Anger management classes through the Court's Alternative Sentencing Office;
- Shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office;
- Shall not possess or consume any illegal controlled substances;
- Shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearms;
- Shall submit to random alcohol and drug testing under the supervision of the Adult Probation Office;
- Shall permit probation to search his person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcohol and illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;
- Shall comply with any other conditions imposed by the Court or the Adult Probation Office;
- Shall comply with any court orders entered against the defendant, including orders of family court or any other local or federal court of competent jurisdiction;
- Shall obey all local and federal laws; and,

- Shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division.

For CM600-13: Sentenced to one (1) year imprisonment, all suspended, with credit for time served; pay \$100 fine, plus Court costs; place on supervised probation for a period of two (2) years with the following recommended terms and conditions of probation:

- Shall report to the Adult Probation Office once a month in person, or as ordered by the Adult Probation Office;
- Shall report to Client Services and Family Counseling Divisions and to Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center for intake and assessment, including drug and alcohol assessment, and shall comply with all treatment recommendations and requirements including paying all related costs of treatment;
- Shall not harass, threaten, physically strike, or injure [victim's name omitted], or any other family or household member. Shall refrain from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing or molesting [victim's name omitted], or any other family or household members;
- Shall stay away, directly and indirectly, from [victim's name omitted], and shall not contact the same wither in person, through a third party, including a family member or friend, by telephone, text message, electronic device, e-mail, and/or any other form of communication, and shall not come within five hundred (500) feet of [victim's name omitted];
- Shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverage or illegal controlled substance or intoxicants;
- Shall stay away from all firearms, and is not to possess, carry, transfer, or use any firearm. It is a violation of federal law under 18 USC § 922 for any person subject to an order of protection or convicted of a crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition, except as required during the course of duty for military or law enforcement employment pursuant to 18 USC § 925;
- Shall permit probation officers and other peace officers to search the Defendant's person, residence, and vehicles for firearms, alcoholic beverages or illegal controlled substances at any time such a search is requested. Failure to allow such a search will be considered a violation of probation;
- Shall perform eighty (80) hours of community service which may be converted to a fine at the current minimum wage rate per hour;
- Shall turn in his passport, and/or other travel documents to the Adult Probation Office;
- Shall not leave Guam without the approval of the Court or Adult Probation Office, with prior notice being given to the Office of the Attorney General, Prosecution Division;
