<b>Punishment prescribed for each offense</b> (30.200(c)(4))	<b>For CM0009-15:</b> <b>Family Violence (As A Misdemeanor)</b> 1. Defendant understands that the maximum sentence for misdemeanor family violence is a year in jail and a \$1000.00 fine. Defendant sentenced to one (1) year with all but credit for time served suspended.

2. Report to Client Services for intake and assessment and follow all treatment recommendations including program attendance at behavioral health programs provided by Guam Behavior health and Wellness Center if recommended by Client Services. Pay for all treatment costs or do community service to work off the treatment costs.
3. Pay restitution to the victim.
4. Alcohol assessment at New Beginnings and follow all treatment recommendations.
5. Random drug and alcohol testing.
6. Contact with the victim is allowed.
7. Defendant agrees to abide by all policies, rules, or regulations of Client Services and Family Counseling or any other treatment agency or provider. Failure to abide by said policies, rules, or regulations may result in a hearing to refer the case for adjudication pursuant to 9 GCA § 30.80.3 or the defendant may be found in contempt of Court pursuant to 7 GCA § 34101.
8. Defendant shall give up all firearms, firearms IDs and permits in defendant's possession to Adult Probation Services until disposition of this case. Defendant shall not live in any residence where firearms are present. It is a violation of Federal Law under 18 USC for any person subject to an order for protection or convicted of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess or receive firearms or ammunition except as required during the course of duty for military or law enforcement employment pursuant to 18 USC §925.
9. Defendant shall obey all federal and local laws.
10. Pursuant to 9 GCA §30.10(b) any bail bond or undertaking on file by or on behalf of the defendant in this case shall be exonerated upon the Court's approval of the plea.

**For CF350-15:**

**Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor)**

1. Sentenced to one (1) year incarceration, all suspended, credit for time served.
2. Placed on Probation for two (2) years, concurrent with the probationary period in CM0009-15, under the following recommendations:
  - a. No harass/assault/threaten the victim and any/all household members;
  - b. Assessment at Client Services and Family Counseling, and comply w/any and all recommended treatment courses which may be concurrent with CM0009-15;
  - c. Pay a \$100 fine or perform 40 hours community service which may be concurrent with CM0009-15, plus court costs;
  - d. No alcohol, illegal drugs and firearms applicable search and testing provisions;
  - e. Obey all laws and do not leave Guam with the Court's
