

OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SUNSHINE ACT OR FREEDOM OF INFORMATION GUIDELINES (INTERIM)

I, Attorney General Leonardo M. Rapadas, hereby authorize the continued adoption of these interim Sunshine Act or Freedom of Information (FOIA) Guidelines for the Office of the Attorney General pursuant to 5 G.C.A. § 10106.

1. Any person making a Sunshine Act or FOIA request to inspect or obtain copies of records or documents from the Office of the Attorney General may make the request to:

2. The limitations on the right to inspect or obtain copies of public records or documents in the possession of the Office of the Guam Attorney General are those limitations indicated in the Sunshine Reform Act of 1999 in Chapter 10 of Title 5 Guam Code Annotated (See e.g., 5 G.C.A. §10104 & §10108), **and other limitations that are provided by law include but are not limited to certain privileges like the attorney-client communication privilege, deliberative process or executive privilege, and attorney work product doctrine.**
3. All Sunshine Act or FOIA request to inspect and or obtain copies of records or documents from the Office of the Attorney General must be immediately brought to the attention of the Deputy Attorney General for the Civil/Solicitors Division.
4. The Deputy Attorney General or designated Assistant Attorney General shall respond to the Sunshine Act or FOIA request with the necessary assistance from other employees in the divisions or sections relevant to the request, as well as consistent with the law.
5. These interim guideline will remain in effect until further notice.
