### **Noamorean Pleads Guilty**

*October 08, 2013- Tamuning, Guam-* Yesterday, Giene Starks Naomorean pled guilty to having sexually abused his victim using force and coercion after he broke into the victim's home in last year. He pled guilty to first degree criminal sexual conduct as a first degree felony and as a result, will spend 22 years in prison.

He is required to register as a level 1 sex offender, the highest level under Guam law, for the rest of his life.

"This is a victory for both the victim and the people of Guam. By getting defendant to plead guilty, the victim avoided having to be re-victimized by testifying at trial, and the people obtained a strong but fair sentence," said Prosecuting Attorney Matthew Heibel.

"The People appreciate having the full cooperation of the victim and her family throughout this process; her willingness to come forward and participate is what made this conviction possible," he continued.
