Damian Convicted

August 5, 2014- Tamuning, Guam- Last Friday, Kurt Damian was convicted after Jurors found him guilty of theft by receiving stolen property as a second degree felony and eluding a police officer as a misdemeanor.

On March 2nd, Damian was identified driving a stolen vehicle and led police on a chase in the Pago Bay area. Damian abandoned the car and then fled on foot. Police apprehended him after a half-mile foot chase.

After further investigation, police discovered that the stolen vehicle had a stolen license plate attached to it.

Based on prior theft convictions, Damian faces up to 10 years imprisoned at the Department of Corrections.

AAG Gerald Henderson who was co-counsel in the Chad DeSoto case, prosecuted and successfully convicted Damian while waiting for a verdict in the DeSoto trial.

“This conviction continues the string of several convictions that have occurred during the jury selection, trial, deliberation, and conviction of DeSoto,” said Attorney General Leonardo M. Rapadas.
