OAG Awarded Platinum Award

December 29, 2015- Tamuning, Guam - The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) was awarded the 1st place Platinum Award from the Association of Government Accounts' (AGA), Guam Chapter, for its Fiscal Year 2014 Citizen-Centric Report (CCR).

The AGA, Guam Chapter, thanked General Barrett-Anderson and the OAG “for promoting accountability and bridging the gap of communication between the government of Guam and its citizens...” through its visually appealing, clear and understandable report.

The AGA, Guam Chapter, awards GovGuam entities that produce the best CCR each fiscal year based on strict guidelines and eligibility requirements. Among the requirements are the following: the completion of fiscal year audited financial statements; submission of the CCR to the Office of Public Accountability within 60 calendar days after the issuance of Audited Financial Statements; and ensuring the CCR is posted on the entity’s website.

Last October, the OAG was awarded a Certificate of Excellence for the same CCR report from the (national) Association of Government Accountants, and was commended for publishing “a report that communicates financial and performance information... that demonstrates accountability and transparency to its citizens.”

The CCR report is mandated by Public Law 30-127 for government agencies to publish it no later than 60 calendar days after their respective annual financial audits.
