**Crown Bakery Kidnapper & Rapist Sentenced to Life Imprisonment**

*February 10, 2015- Tamuning, Guam* – Raymond Tedtaotao Camacho will spend the rest of his life imprisoned at the Department of Corrections without the possibility of parole as a result of his heinous actions early one morning back in October 2012.

Camacho's victim arrived at Crown Bakery early one morning and, upon returning to her car, was held at gunpoint and forced to drive to another location. Camacho then threatened to kill her, attacked and mercilessly raped her, and stole her belongings- a credit card among them.

Raymond Tedtaotao and Corina Lynn Blas, who admitted to using the stolen credit card and pleaded guilty, are currently serving time at the Department of Corrections. Tedtaotao, who is a repeat offender and criminal mastermind, will stay incarcerated at DOC indefinitely for convictions in his other cases, particularly for his complete disregard for human life in the Nimitz Hill home invasion case.
