AG Responds to FestPac Comments on Procurement

March 18, 2016-Tamuning, Guam-Attorney General Elizabeth Barrett-Anderson, in response to the Governor's Office press release, statements made by the Chairman for the FestPac Organizing Committee Nathan Denight and Department of Chamorro Affairs President Joseph Cameron, says

"The contract approved by the OAG is limited to the \$800,000.00 that was negotiated for the scope of services of the contractor to assist in planning the upcoming events. It was further clarified to the FestPac Committee that procurement beyond this limitation could not be conducted through the contract."

"The FestPac Committee is now aware of the procurement limitations under their present vendor contract, and the critical procurement difficulties they face in the months ahead. As with all sectors of the community, our Office supports the success of this enormous undertaking to showcase our island, and in doing so we will assist the FestPac Committee to make sure they comply with government procurement laws," she stated.
