30-Year Old Man Convicted for Criminal Sexual Conduct

May 24, 2016- Tamuning, Guam- Raymond Manuel Ledesma, a 30-year old man who sexually assaulted two young children, both 7 years-of-age, was convicted late yesterday afternoon on two counts of second degree criminal sexual conduct as a first degree felony and two counts of child abuse as a misdemeanor.

Sometime last year, when the two victims were left alone with Ledesma, he ordered them to his bedroom and instructed both children to remove their shorts. He sexually assaulted them by placing his genitals on their buttocks.

Ledesma faces anywhere from 3 years to 15 years for each count of criminal sexual conduct and up to one year for each misdemeanor charge. His scheduled to be sentenced on September 09, 2016.

“The young victims were very brave to face their perpetrator in open court,” said Assistant Attorney General Lisa Lorig.
