## **'Wreck It, Replace It' Initiative Repairs Fence**

June 07, 2017- Tamuning, Guam- Yet another individual was held accountable for the repair of government property under the "Wreck It, Replace It" initiative spearheaded by the Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General.

In September 2016, an individual collided with the raised median chain link fence located on Route 1 Marine Corps Drive directly in front of John F. Kennedy high school. The operator of the vehicle fell asleep at the wheel, severely damaging the fence that divides the northern & southern bound lanes. The fence line repair was completed over the weekend at a cost of \$4,690.00

"We the taxpayers shouldn't have to pick up the tab for damages to our roadways caused by negligent drivers. This program sends a stern message, You Wreck It, Your Replace It!" said Attorney General Barrett-Anderson.
