Drug Dealer Convicted

March 01, 2019, Tamuning, Guam- Phillip Vincent Caso was convicted today after a jury found him guilty of Delivery of Schedule II Controlled Substance with Intent to Deliver as a First Degree Felony and Possession of a Schedule II Controlled Substance as Third Degree Felony.

A controlled buy was arranged and conducted in September 2018 at Caso's residence in Ligan Terrace by the Guam Police Department's (GPD) Mandaña Drug Task Force. Using a source of information, the officers were able to obtain ice from Caso.

Judge Sukola will sentence Caso on May 6, 2019. He faces up to five years imprisonment at the Department of Corrections.

"Our island is being targeted by drug dealers. Be forewarned, there will be consequences. The fine men and women with GPD's Mandaña Drug Task Force, and the Office of the Attorney General Prosecution Division are always at the ready in pursuit of justice," said Prosecuting Attorney Matthew Phelps.
