“Gameroom Robber Gets 10 Years”

February 08, 2019, Tamuning, Guam-Jonovan Michael Cruz was sentenced today to 10 years imprisoned at the Department of Corrections.

In March 2017, Cruz entered a gameroom wearing a mask and wielding a knife at the cashier, robbing the gameroom of \$6,000.

“The People of Guam would like to thank the Mandana Drug Task Force for its work on the string of robberies that were occurring across the island. Residents of Guam are safer with violent criminals taken off the streets,” said Assistant Attorney General Christine Tenorio.

He was convicted of Second Degree Robbery as a Second Degree Felony with a Special Allegation for the Possession or Use of a Deadly Weapon in the Commission of a Felony and Theft as a Second Degree Felony with a Special Allegation for the Possession or Use of Deadly Weapon in the Commission of a Felony.

“It took teamwork to bring the defendant to justice. We want to thank the hardworking officers of the Guam Police Department for their dedication in investigating and apprehending the defendant. GPD’s efforts led to the successful prosecution of this case,” said Attorney General Leevin T. Camacho.

“The sentence imposed today will hopefully send a clear message that we will seek the maximum punishment for violent criminals.,” he finished.
