John Nego Convicted for Theft of a Motor Vehicle

March 07, 2019, Tamuning, Guam- John Daniel Nego was found guilty today by a jury of his peers for Theft of a Motor Vehicle, Forgery and Impersonation.

Assistant Attorney General (AAG) Christine Tenorio prepared the case and AAG Jeremiah Luther presented the matter to the jury.

“We want to thank the jury for their service. Our office was able to secure this verdict with the thorough work done by the Guam Police Department and detectives with the Property Crimes Unit of the Criminal Investigation Division,” said AAG Luther.

“A lot of our residents buy and sell vehicles without first verifying who owns the vehicle or the payment method. If a deal sounds too good to be true, then it probably is. This case is a reminder that you should always check twice before you buy or sell a car, boat, or other big item,” AAG Luther continued.

“Stolen cars and forged checks are too often the norm in Guam. It’s too easy to end up with a stolen vehicle or a bad check and find yourself without your car, boat, or the money in your pocket. There’s nothing rude about asking a seller to prove ownership or calling a bank to make sure a check is valid,” said AAG Tenorio.
