Thomas Ray Aguon Convicted of Family Violence

February 15, 2019, Tamuning, Guam-Thomas Ray Aguon was convicted of Family Violence as a Third Degree Felony today.

“We are pleased that the jury returned a guilty verdict for felony family violence in this case. They deliberated over the course of three days before returning the guilty verdict,” said Prosecuting Attorney Thomas Neuman.

The jury acquitted Aguon of three counts of Third Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct as a Second Degree Felony.

“We are disappointed with the not guilty verdict for the sexual abuse charge, but hopefully the victim has received closure and can move on with her life. She was in a violent relationship with the defendant for many years, and finally found the courage to leave him,” continued Prosecuting Attorney Rolland Wimberley, who co-chaired this trial.

Aguon will be sentenced on May 2, 2019. He is facing up to five years imprisoned at the Department of Corrections.
