Muna Only to Serve One Year in Jail

Hagatna, Guam- Jerrett Taisapic Muna was sentenced today to five years for aggravated assault as a third degree felony, rioting as a third degree felony and assault as a misdemeanor to run concurrently, but all was suspended except for one year.

Despite the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) Prosecution Team's arguments for the maximum sentencing of 12 years, the defendant will only actually serve just one year in prison.

In February 2011, Muna intercepted and flipped an ATV being ridden by his victim in the immediate aftermath of a riot, inflicting serious bodily injury to the victim who had to be hospitalized for over a month.

The OAG is deeply disappointed with the courts sentencing given the serious and grievous life-changing injuries suffered by the victim.
